New	Toothed, wooly, gray-green leaves form mats with 15cm flower stems that bear corms of pale yellow flowers, which age to cream.

	Tiny tuft (4-8cm) of glaucous leaves, delicately covered in pink flowers. M. Pavelka collection from stony slopes, gypsum hills in Kangal, Turkey.

	From Turkey, this low shrublet has blue, needle like foliage with pink blooms in late spring.

New	Mike Kintgen ex Bluebird		
A0005	Aethionema ibirideum	Sun Part-sun	\$13
	Small growing crucifer with trailing stems forming loose mats; blue gray leaves and maroon stems; white, fragrant flowers.		
A0280	Aethionema saxatilis	Sun	\$12
New	Blue-green, thick (almost succulent like) leaves form a low cushion of 10-15cm. Flowers are usually pink, but there is variability with white and mauve as well. Jurasek collection, 1700m Greece.		
A0198	Aethionema subulatum	Sun Part-sun	\$13
	Compact tufts of woody stems with bluish leaves; large rose/pink flowers on short scapes.		
A0394	Agave havardiana	Sun	\$13
	Gorgeous 60cm blue-gray succulent basal rosette. Very sharp, dark spines. Alpains Davis Mountain collection; Jeff Davis CO., TX, 1860m. Listed for Zone 6-7.		
A0199	Agave lechuguilla	Sun	\$13
	Found at 1494m, El Paso Co., Texas. This is a hardy collection with typical dagger like stems and etched patterning.		
A0006	Agave parryi	Sun	\$13
	A hardy Alpains collection from Grant Co., NM at 2073m, where it experiences a good amount of winter cold.		
A0345	Ajania khartensis	Sun	\$13
New	A welcome bloom of yellow buttons in late summer on low, creeping silver leaves; 5-10cm in height. Holubec collection; limestone scree, grasslands, Baima Shan, Yunnan at 4300m.		
A0407	Ajania tenuifolia	Sun	\$13
	Silver pinnatisect leaves; cluster of yellow florets; 15cm. Josef Jurasek collection from China.		
A0432	Alchemilla saxatilis	Sun Part-sun Shade	\$12
	Dwarf Lady's Mantle with glossy, deep green leaves, enhanced further with silver edges.		
A0448	Alkanna stribrnyi	Sun	\$13
New	M. Rejzek collection; Ex. Osogovo 550m, North Macedonia; 10-30cm; sunny place and poor, stony soil; neutral – alkaline.		
A0408	Allium caesium	Sun	\$13
	Elegant 20-40cm stems of pale azure blue globes that hold up for a good long time in mid-summer. For sunny, well drained spot in the garden. M. Pavelka collection at 2400m, Tian-Shan, Kyrgyzstan.		
A0429	Allium carinatum ssp. pulchellum	Sun	\$12
	Stems (10-50cm high) of pendulous reddish-purple blooms in late summer. M. Rejzek collection from Nanos Slovenia, 1070m.		
A0437	Allium carolinianum	Sun Part-sun	\$13
New	From Himalayan slopes; broad, glaucous leaves with round heads of pink flowers in early summer.		
A0382	Allium cupanii ssp. hirtovaginatium	Sun	\$12
	Tuft of linear leaves, just 5-10cm in height. Large pink flowers, varying from light to dark pink in colour. Choice collection by M. Pavelka; Ulu Dag, Turkey.

	Flat linear leaves; early summer nodding cluster of magenta blooms with rounded petals, 20cm high. J. Jurasek collection from Yunnan, China at 3500m.

	Dwarf form from Turkey with umbels of bright yellow flowers; delightfully curled leaves, 12cm.		
A0288	Allium kurtzianum	Sun	\$12
	Dense pinkish-purple clusters in summer. Grows to just 10cm high; excellent trough specimen. Rare endemic of NW Turkey; J. Jurasek collection.		
A0441	Allium macedonicum	Sun	\$14
New	Elegant umbels of striped light pink/yellow florets on 15-40 cm stems. For dry, sunny garden with good drainage and neutral to alkaline soil. M. Rejzek collection from Babuna, North Macedonia at 1250m.		
A0443	Allium pskemense	Sun	\$14
New	Long inflated leaves with creamy white spherical blooms in summer. Related to the common edible Allium cepa.		
A0385	Allium Rawu	Sun	\$12
	Pink flowered allium; from Jurasek seed collected in Rawu, E. Tibet at 4100m.		
A0362	Allium senescens ssp. glaucum	Sun	\$12
	The bluish-gray, flat, curling "cowlick onion" leaves just can't be ignored in any garden, including the rockery. Drought tolerant, deer resistant, and a much appreciated late summer bloomer of pink globes. Half the size of the species with leaves reaching 15cm in height.		
A0284	Allium sikkimense	Sun	\$14
	Very desirable thin leaved, petite blue allium for rock garden and trough. A more than welcome bloom in August and September.		
A0386	Allium sphaerocephalon	Sun	\$12
	Stems (60cm) hold dense, oval, drumstick flower heads, oddly resembling maroon-red clover. Grassy leaves are elegant, thin and about 40cm in height. M. Rejzek collection from Ereğ Dagi, Turkey at 2000m.		
A0307	Allium thunbergii alba	Sun	\$12
	Just when you think the garden is done for the season, this easy to please gem brightens the day. Forms tidy clumps; stems 20cm high hold clear white blooms until frost.		
A0318	Allium thunbergii 'Ozawa'	Sun Part-sun	\$12
New	Late blooming flowers last for months, even after light frosts! Elegant 'Ozawa' flowers are held about 30cm high; rich purple with reddish undertones. Delicate, grassy leaves don't distract from the blooms. Very easy to grow, and the deer of course don't like them. From Gabriella Costea seed.		
A0438	Allium togashii	Sun Part-sun	\$14
New	Tiny (10-15cm), grassy onion from Japan; pale lavender-pink blooms in August.		
A0194	Allium virgunculae	Sun	\$12
	A very dainty 10cm allium with thin green leaves in a neat tuft bearing blue/purple flowers in the autumn until frost.		
A0436	Alyssum armenum	Sun	\$14
	Large yellow flowers on 5-10cm subshrub of small grey leaves. M. Pavelka collection from gypsum hills, Palandoken, Turkey.		
A0439	Alyssum haussknechtii	Sun	\$14
New	Extremely choice and tiny (2-4cm) silver cushion covered in yellow flowers. M. Pavelka collection from Tahtali Dag, Turkey rocky slopes.		
A0324	Alyssum oxycarpum	Sun	\$12
	Tiny grey green leaves with profusion of yellow blooms. 20cm high mounds naturalize and brighten garden edges in summer.		
A0008	Alyssum propinquum	Sun	\$14
New	Condensed mats of gray/green leaves and stems. Mostly spring flowering, they do resume growth and blooming from September onwards, staying evergreen through the winter and often flowering through the snow. Tolerant of heat and cold; very effective in combination with Acantholimon and Dianthus.		
A0392	Alyssum repens ssp. repens	Sun	\$12
New	Procumbent stems spread across the ground, ending in striking clusters of large golden flowers. J. Jurasek collection from Romania.		
A0455	Alyssum sp. 'Bayburt'	Sun	\$14
New	Cushions of tiny silver leaves, just 5-10cm in height, sprinkled with yellow flowers. M. Pavelka collection from rocky slopes; Bayburt, Turkey.

	The Nepal Pearly Everlasting; fuzzy lanceolate, silver-green leaves. Papery white flowers; 20cm tall. Sichuan, 3000m; grown from Pavel Krivka seed.

	A collection from northern Canada which has proven to be a good grower; needle like leaves of bluish green; pink flowers; 30cm.

New	Thick tufts of woody stems, wooly leaves, white flowers.		
A0158	Androsace brachystegia	Sun	\$14
New	Many tiny rosettes of soft leaves with huge white flowers. A new Chinese collection from Jurasek. A definite candidate for a choice trough.		
A0216	Androsace globifera	Sun Part-sun	\$16
	Halda collected seed of this species in Upper Burma on Mali Kha in a high alpine pasture (4800m); stemless, lavender flowers sit atop tight cushions of hairy leaves, resembling a miniature form of a. muscoidea, very choice introduction.		
A0200	Androsace mariae v. tibetica	Sun	\$16
	Small rosettes of stiff green leaves topped with rose coloured flowers; the best form of this variable species, it makes tight, compact cushions from northerly and drier Quinghai.		
A0118	Androsace muscoidea	Sun Part-sun	\$16
	Very choice, silvery green, stoloniferous cushion; stemless lavender flowers; from drier regions of the Himalaya.		
A0010	Androsace primuloides 'Sheppard'	Sun Part-sun	\$14
	Large vigorous plant with many gray-green rosettes of elliptic leaves, each one producing, in May, a compact umbel of pink flowers with a yellow eye, lovely where given the room to form a solid carpet.		
A0154	Androsace sarmentosa	Sun Part-sun	\$13
	From a wild collection at 3300m, Garwal. Soft cushions of lanate leaves, rose/pink flowers with a dark eye; spreads into larger mats.		
A0162	Androsace tangulashanensis	Sun	\$16
	Tiny, tiny rosettes in dense clusters; stemless, white flowers; choice. From limestone grassy screes; Madoi.		
A0189	Androsace x 'millstream'	Sun	\$14
	Linc Foster's selection of a tiny garden seedling with dark green leaves and pink flowers.		
A0478	Anemone multifida 'Major'	Sun Part-sun	\$13
New	Small, yet easy, 25cm tall clump; creamy white, upright flowers in summer.		
A0203	Anemone multifida v. tetonensis	Sun	\$13
	Late spring flower colour can vary from strawberry pink to purple and white. Lanate leaves with flower stems 10-20cm stems high.		
A0098	Anemone parviflora	Sun Part-sun	\$14
	Dark green, basal leaves; short stems bearing bluish/white flowers.		
A0320	Anemone sp. Sichuan	Sun Part-sun	\$14
	Low growing tuft with almost prostrate stems of white flowers when open, but distinctive purple undersides of petals are what really add the interest. Not showy, but very subtly attractive. J. Jurasek collection ex Sichuan in 2013.		
A0145	Anemone x lesseri	Sun Part-sun	\$13
	A garden origin hybrid with shiny green, palmate leaves, to 15cm tall; many rose flowers about 2cm across.		
A0298	Anemonopsis macrophylla	Part-sun Shade	\$16
New	Incredibly elegant 'false anemone' that should have a place in everyone's shade garden. Nodding opalescent flowers resemble a cross between an anemone and a fuchsia, with light violet waxy outer sepals and an inner cup of infused deep violet. From woodland areas in central Honshu, Japan. Grown from a thick packet of seed Barrie Porteous sent.		
A0070	Antennaria dioica 'nyewoods'	Sun Part-sun	\$14
New	A fine pink flowered form. Makes dense carpets of green and silver.		
A0413	Antennaria parvifolia 'McClintock'	Sun	\$14
New	White everlasting flowers, but mostly grown for its intricate silver leaves that form a low (7cm) mat.

A0285	Anthemis cretica ssp. carpatica	Sun	\$13
New	Large solitary white flowers in summer on cushions of silvery-grey pinnatisect leaves. Jurasek collection from Ulu Dag, Turkey; 2100m.		
A0165	Anthemis cretica ssp. leucanthemoides	Sun Part-sun	\$13
New	From Turkey, an absolutely flat mat with filigreed silvery green leaves and white flowers; the best form.		
A0129	Anthemis marschalliana	Sun	\$15
	Tufted mats of finely divided powdery white leaves, topped with deep yellow flowers- very striking; 7cm tall.		
A0425	Aquilegia chrysantha	Sun	\$12
	The Golden Columbine, a vigorous 40cm clump of ferny foliage, crowned in 7cm lemon yellow blooms mid-summer. Native of the southern Rocky Mountains.		
A0299	Aquilegia hybrid Porteous	Sun Part-sun	\$13
	Large, fully purple blooms; plant forms a tidy and compact mound at 15-30cm high. From Barrie Porteous' garden.		
A0264	Aquilegia saximontana	Sun	\$15
	Endemic to the Front Range in Colorado, this is a choice and petite columbine. Nodding flowers are a bright blue-purple and white; tidy blue-green leaves.		
A0373	Aquilegia scopulorum Sanpete Co (UT)		\$16
	Tight gray-green tuft, from a larger growing population. Sizable bi-colored blue and white blooms with long spurs. Alplains collection from south and east-facing screes of dolomite near timberline in Sanpete Co., UT at 3290m.		
A0421	Arabis androsacea	Sun	\$14
New	The flowers are that of the typical four petaled white Arabis, but the tight 4cm high cushion looks for all the world like a silvery Androsace villosa. Nice specimen for an alkaline, gritty crevice or trough. M. Rejzek collection from Bolkar Daglari, Turkey, 2760m.		
A0423	Arabis aubrietoides	Sun	\$14
New	The rosy-purple flowers and 10cm mound of deeply toothed leaves resemble an Aubretia more than an Arabis, but an Arabis it is. M. Pavelka collection from limestone ledges, Bolkar Dag, Turkey.		
A0287	Arabis bryoides	Sun Part-sun	\$14
New	Tidy, tight cushion of heavily tomentose leaves giving it a soft appearance. Covered in white flowers in spring.		
A0021	Arabis ferdinandi-coburgii 'Variegata'	Sun Part-sun	\$12
New	Waxy leaves with a yellow/green variegation. Useful mat-forming species; white flowers.		
A0254	Arabis x suendermannii	Sun Part-sun	\$13
New	A lovely mat forming species from Rick Lupp with overlapping rosettes of elongated, lustrous green leaves; small white flowers. The visual texture of the mat is beautiful and unusual, especially for an arabis.		
A0041	Arctostaphylos uva ursi 'Wood's Red'	Sun	\$15
	Excellent dwarf form. Mats of dark green leaves. Delicate pink lanterns followed by red fruits.		
A0371	Arenaria grandiflora	Sun	\$13
	Large white flowers on a dense tuft, just 5-15cm in height. For well drained, neutral to alkaline scree in full sun. M. Rejzek collection from Alpes Maritimes, France at 1250m.		
A0377	Arenaria hookeri v. desertorum	Sun	\$16
	Very choice, tight, cushion with exceptionally fine needle like leaves; becomes a mound of white blooms in early summer. Alplains collection from Uintah Co., UT at 2302m.		
A0025	Arenaria tetraquetra	Sun	\$13
	Dense, hard green mat of tetragonus leaves; many white, stem-less flowers in May. Use as a mat to intergrow with something larger such as dianthus or bulbs.		
A0095	Arenaria tetraquetra ssp. granatensis	Sun	\$15
	One of the tightest mats I have seen; ground hugging little hummocks of light green and gold; especially attractive growing on tufa. The white flowers are stemless ~1cm wide. Excellent for combining with other mats or to use as a "dry" underplant for bulbs or a small alpine campanula, gentian or primula.

	Grown from seed from a Czech collection in Turkey, this is not keyed out, but is so good that it must be listed. Narrow blades of grey/green form a dwarf, soft mound; many white flowers with distinctive purple striping are borne in the heat of summer making a valued addition at this time of year; 6cm.		
A0051	Arenaria Wallowa Mts	Sun Part-sun	\$13
	Solid green hummocks with white flowers on 1 inch stems. A very tight, wonderful cushion.		
A0401	Armeria canescens	Sun	\$12
New	Taller thrift in bloom, 20-30cm, yet still elegant with its pink globes held high above the moppish mounds of long linear leaves. Collection from Montenegro.		
A0376	Armeria girardii	Sun	\$13
New	Grassy tufts of narrow leaves; small pink globes held on threadlike stems; 8-15cm high. Specific to the Caucasus and Dolomite sands; a M. Rejzek collection from Cevennes, France at 1000m.		
A0028	Armeria juniperifolia	Sun Part-sun	\$13
	Hummock forming Spanish Thrift, very compact; lots of pink flowers on 5cm stems.		
A0029	Armeria juniperifolia 'Alba'	Sun	\$13
	A white flowered version with more glaucous leaves and condensed habit. It does best in very dry sand and full sun.		
A0030	Armeria juniperifolia 'Bevan's Variety'	Sun Part-sun	\$15
	A diminutive form, very compact making the cushion almost hard. Stemless rose pink pompoms cover it in early spring.		
A0135	Armeria scabra ssp. sibirica	Sun	\$13
	An oddity from the middle Rockies found on drier areas of alpine tundra; flat tufts of short, grassy leaves; opalescent spheres on short 10cm stems.		
A0049	Armeria x 'Little Penny'	Sun	\$13
New	A tiny armeria with stemless crimson pink flowers on a tight mound of red-purple foliage.		
A0181	Artemisia frigida	Sun	\$14
	A high collection ~3300m, Utah; small woody crowned shrub with spreading branches of silvery blue/gray foliage; flowers are small yellow discs on 10cm stems.		
A0056	Artemisia pedemontana v. assoana	Sun	\$15
New	White, wooly mats, perfect to fill a vertical crevice. Yellow flower heads in June; 5cm; trough.		
A0435	Artemisia stelleriana 'Mori's Strain'	Sun	\$14
New	Attractive prostrate form; 20cm mound of white, pinnatifid leaves. For well drained rockery in full sun.		
A0222	Aruncus aethusifolius	Sun Part-sun Shade	\$12
	Native to Japan and Korea; low mounds of finely divided leaves with airy plumes of white flowers over a long period; tolerates dry, shaded sites.		
A0053	Asperula daphneola	Sun	\$15
New	Dense, small, grey-green mats with long, stemless, funnel-shaped pink flowers. Very choice; Pavelka collection from stony slopes of Nif Dag, Turkey.		
A0054	Asperula nitida	Sun	\$14
New	Long tubed pink flowers in head-like clusters amongst green mat forming foliage.		
A0063	Asperula pontica	Sun	\$14
New	Dense cushion of green curls with a touch of frost on the margins. Long tubes of dark pink; excellent for crevice or trough.		
A0172	Asphodeline taurica	Sun Part-sun	\$14
	Long, thin leaves erupting from the base of a thickened stock. The 40cm high flower spikes carry hundreds of stemless white flowers; an accent plant popular with garden visitors.		
A0461	Aster alpinus v. dolomiticus	Sun	\$14
New	M. Rejzek collection; Pirin 2080m., Bulgaria; 5-15 cm; sunny but not dry place, poor stony soil, good drainage. Neutral – alkaline.		
A0295	Aster diplostephioides	Sun	\$13
	Large, and extremely thin petalled purple daisy - that's what makes it striking. A taller alpine, at 20-45 cm. Jurasek collection, N. Qinghai, 3600m.

	Hot magenta blooms from August to September. Only ~20cm tall.

	Very low with sharply toothed leaves; pale pink flowers.		
A0043	Astragalus angustifolius	Sun	\$15
	Received from Fred Case, this woody plant makes an excellent mat of silver divided leaves and white pea flowers. Easy to grow, and excellent draped over rocks.		
A0424	Asyneuma ilgazense	Sun	\$13
New	Basal rosette of wavy linear leaves; unbranched 10cm spike covered with stunning pale violet-blue flowers. M. Rejzek collection, rare, Ex. Ilgaz Daglari, Turkey; 2020m.		
A0353	Aubrieta canescens ssp. macrostyla	Sun	\$13
	Choice grey cushions; pale violet flowers. Pavelka collection from Sultan Dag, Turkey.		
A0039	Aubrieta gracilis	Sun Part-sun	\$13
	Mats of tiny green leaves; profuse, purple flowers in May.		
A0387	Aubrieta libanotica	Sun	\$13
	The Lebanese rock cress; tiny, 2-6cm cushions of small, violet flowers. M. Rejzek collection from Mount Lebanon at 1620m.		
A0040	Aubrieta x marjorie	Sun Part-sun	\$13
	Large mat of gray-green leaves; bright magenta flowers.		
A0359	Azalea 'Baby Dane'	Sun Part-sun	\$18
	Bunches of pure white flowers cover this little shrub that grows to just 25cm in height. We received this very compact evergreen azalea from John Weagle, a cross by Jens Birck of Denmark ('Panda' x kiusianum 'Album').		
A0360	Azalea japonica 'Kermesina Rosea'	Part-sun	\$18
	Unusual and striking pink flowers with clear white margins, cover this compact shrub in late spring. Small, dark green leaves; shrubby mound reaches just 60cm in height after 10 years.		
A0265	Azorella trifurcata	Sun Part-sun	\$13
	Ground hugging mats of hard, rubbery foliage. Tiny yellow/green flowers sit on the carpet.		
B0025	Bergenia crassifolia	Sun Part-sun Shade	\$12
	Clump of leathery, obovate leaves, to about 30cm tall. Panicles of pink flowers in spring. Grow in moist, humus rich soil; even tolerates full shade. Eastern Sayan Mountains, E. Siberia at 2100m.

New	An odd subshrub with intricately arranged branches and small, linear leaves. Umbels of yellow flowers in spring; drought tolerant; 25cm.
